

## “When You Pray, Part 2: The Lord’s Prayer”

Text: Matthew 6:9-13 (NKJV)

<sup>9</sup> In this manner, therefore, pray:

Our Father in heaven,  
Hallowed be Your name.

<sup>10</sup> Your kingdom come.

Your will be done  
On earth as *it is* in heaven.

<sup>11</sup> Give us this day our daily bread.

<sup>12</sup> And forgive us our debts,  
As we forgive our debtors.

<sup>13</sup> And do not lead us into temptation,  
But deliver us from the evil one.

For Yours is the kingdom and the power and the glory forever. Amen.

How should we pray?

Our prayers should begin “God-ward,” with a focus on God. The model prayer Jesus gives us emphasized three areas:

**Relationship** – “Our Father in heaven”

**Worship** – “Hallowed be Your name”

**Lordship** - Your kingdom come. Your will be done  
On earth as *it is* in heaven
